The highlight of every week is a chance to video the online Worship service. Believe me, when this pandemic first started I was very nervous to get in front of a camera! My style of preaching had been to write my sermon out, then reduce it to an outline, then preach extemporaneously (often without notes) from the outline. I quickly realized that style wouldn't work when



every word you are preaching is being captured on film! Weeks of Scripture study and prayer and pondering and writing (and re-writing) goes into every Service, so by the time Tuesday morning arrives I am excited/anxious, eager to see what the Holy Spirit is going to do for all of us through the Worship experience for the week. That's where the DREAM TEAM comes in! (Feel free to hum along with your favorite super-hero theme music as I make introductions.) First, there is retired television cameraman/sound tech extraordinaire Dennis Yoder, always ready with a kind word and his considerable know how (not to mention Betty's suggestions for improvements from the previous week's tapings – she's got a great eye); Second, there is retired Pastor Joe Carmichael, with his humor, his encouragement, and his creativity; Sometimes Mariah Diego is there to help with filming, with her gentle kindness, and Dan Mitchell, with his contagious laughter. After the taping, Pastor Joe works many hours on weaving together what we have captured, along with music and visuals, to make the Online Worship POP. I know you



agree that we are blessed with a powerful Christian journey every week. That's thanks in large part to Pastor Joe. 

Campfire Time - Sundays at 11:00am on ZOOM - next meeting February 7.



The Methodist Senior Apartments (MSA) and Ministry Center Exploratory Committee Interim Report to Galt United Methodist Church Council January 28, 2021

'The vision of our rehabilitation and expansion of space follows Galt United Methodist Church's core mission and beliefs. We are a Christian community dedicated to serving those in need, elevating lives spiritually, being a presence for those lacking in fundamental support both spiritually or financially, and be active stewards of all that God has given us.'

On October 27, 2020, the first meeting was held with members invited by Pastor Mary Maaga. Meetings take place every 2 weeks. Positions and areas of focus for each member is:

Earl Aarants -	Co-Chair and Church Liaison
Pam Carmichael -	Co-Chair and Committee Support
Mark King -	City Service Connection (Rotary officer) and Construction insights (title industry)
Leesa Klotz -	City, County and School connections
Mary Maaga -	UMC Conference connection and Spiritual lead

- The three lots are in the Galt Old Town District and the City representatives are thrilled that there is discussion towards building on the properties. Pro Bono Real Estate reports have been created on them.
- We are exploring Non-Profit vs For Profit. Church conference development strategists say there are pros and cons for both.
- O The initial concept is a 3 story structure with complimentary facade as the Galt Place Apartments. The top 2 stories would be living units and the 1st floor a multi use Ministry Center, including an expanded and permanent Food Pantry, church offices and other ministries. Preliminary number of 1-room units has been estimated at 30-40.
- The apartment community would be available to both seniors and veterans. We are interested in seeing who would, right now, be interested in living here.
- Both our District Superintendent Debra Brady and Bishop Carcano are enthusiastically behind the project, helping gather contacts within Church Development groups as well as endowment sources.
- At the bishop's recommendation, the team was introduced to Sidney Stone, Director of Real Estate Development at Christian Church homes. We've met via Zoom and provided an onsite walkthrough of the properties and Food Bank.
- Galt City officials are also enthused about the potential ministry to the City, and are actively engaged. Those include:
