Years ago I was given a wonderful plant by a dear friend. She told me exactly where to plant it, how deep to dig the hole, what fertilizer to put in the soil, and how often to water it. I am not a gardener, so I needed those very specific instructions! In a matter of weeks the most wonderful blossoms appeared – they looked like 4th of July sparklers in bright blue, perched atop an improbably thin stem. These blossoms gave me delight every time I entered our front door. In time, they faded and died away, as all blossoms do, and I missed them. I mentioned that I am not a gardener, right? I thought that was the end, that I would need to receive a whole new plant in order to enjoy those wonderful blossoms. What joy, when the following year the blossoms returned without any effort on my part this time! The work that I had put in the previous year – the location, the depth of the hole, the fertilizer, and the commitment to watering – continued to provide what was needed for growth. What a powerful spiritual lesson! I believe that the work we put in to practice a Holy Lent this year will provide beauty and healing for your heart and soul for years to come. Lent Journey 2021: GROWING FAITH



The symbolic power of forty days and forty nights runs throughout Holy Scripture: Noah with 40 days of flood before the rainbow; Moses with 40 days on the Holy mountain receiving the laws of God; Jesus our Lord for 40 days in the wilderness defeating temptation; and us every year during the season of Lent. The season between Ash Wednesday and Holy Week is called Lent, which means "spring" and can include pledges by Christian people to fast – as in "give something up for Lent" – or increased commitment to prayer, learning, or Worship. The

hymn "Lord, Who Throughout These Forty Days" is a powerful guide to the spiritual work in the 40 days ahead.

Verse 1 invites us to **mourn our sins** – it is an invitation to engage in healthy shame and a desire to do better. *Lord, who throughout these forty days for us didst fast and pray, teach us with Thee to mourn our sins and close by Thee to stay.*

Verse 2 invites us to **be strong through Christ to battle our sin** – we are more than conquerors through Christ who loves us. *As Thou with Satan didst contend, and didst the victory win, O give us strength in Thee to fight, in Thee to conquer sin.*

Verse 3 invites us to **put God before all earthly desires** – seeking first the Kingdom of God is an ongoing spiritual discipline. *As Thou didst hunger bear, and thirst, so teach us, gracious Lord, to die to self, and chiefly live by Thy most holy word.*

Verse 4 invites us to **make a home in our heart for the Lord Jesus Christ** – prayer, Worship, loving kindness, the fruits of the Spirit. *And through these days of penitence, and through Thy passiontide, yea, evermore in life and death, Jesus with us abide.*

Verse 5 invites us to **anticipate heaven** – Christ's victory over sin on Good Friday and death on Easter morning through His Resurrection. *Abide with us, that so, this life of suffering over past, an Easter of unending joy we may attain at last.*

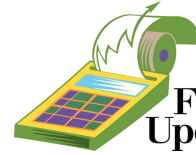

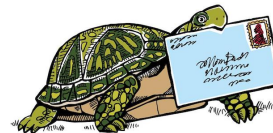
To fund all our staff and programs without dipping into savings we need \$13,500 in giving per month.

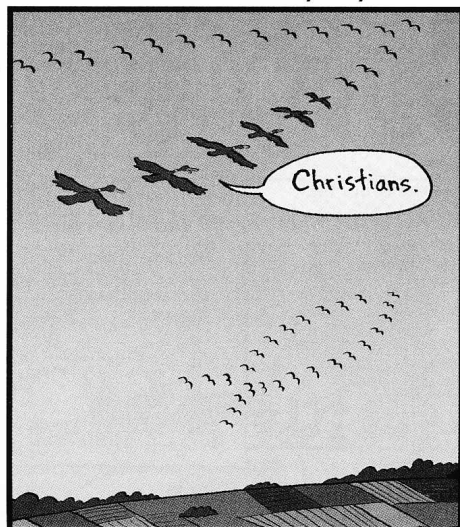
Campfire Time - Sundays on ZOOM - next meeting February 21, at **9:00am**

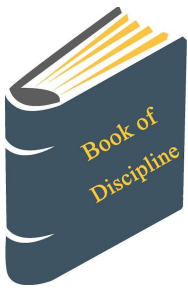

Methodist Book of Discipline
(2016)**

This is from the section on "Our Theological Task" subsection "Scripture":

We properly read Scripture within the believing community, informed by the tradition of that community. We interpret individual texts in light of their place in the Bible as a whole. We are aided by scholarly inquiry and personal insight, under the guidance of the Holy Spirit. As we work with each text, we take into account what we have been able to learn about the original context and intention of that text. In this understanding we draw upon the careful historical, literary, and textual studies of recent years, which have enriched our understanding of the Bible.

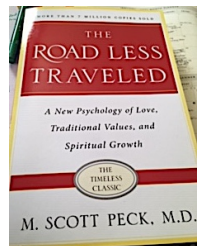
Ever seen a little smudge mark on someone's forehead as they walk out of church? That's a sign of the cross and it means it's Ash Wednesday during Lent.
