

#### God's Kids Say & Do the Funniest Things


"I sure am happy to see you grandma," the little boy said to his grandmother, his mother's mother. "Now maybe Daddy will do the trick he has been promising us."

#### How the Bible Was Made Has Begun!

For those of you who have not signed up for the class, but are interested in its content here is the outline for **Session One: A Living Religion Becomes a Collection of Writings** 

#### Why a New Testament?

Paul's need to stay in connection with the Churches he has planted

Converts asking about Christ, His teachings, and the meaning of His death

Jesus as the Messiah – and the interpretation of OT Scriptures – not as understandable to the uneducated Jewish poor or Gentiles

Combat heresies (more in Session Three)

#### Jesus: How do we know what He said and did?

Oral tradition – repetition of teachings (30CE – 65CE)

"Sayings" Source aka "Q" for "Quelle" (which means "source" in German)

Paul's letters earlier than the Gospels: 1 Thessalonians, Galatians, 1 Corinthians, 2 Corinthians, Philemon, Philippians, Romans

\*Paul's first letter to the Thessalonians, the oldest book in the NT – written in the early  $50 \mathrm{sCE}$ 

\*Meant for reading aloud from start to finish in Worshiping community

\*Paul interested in why Christ died and for whom, not how Christ lived

#### The Gospels: Four portraits vs. Unified story

Synoptic Gospels (synoptic means "seen together"): Jesus speaks in short sayings and parables, and preaches a coming reign of God

Mark 65CE

Luke/Matthew 85CE- they share "Q" Sayings Source, plus Mark

John 100CE – Jews expelled Jesus's followers from the synagogues in the 90sCE, thus the anti-Jewish content; long discourses, sermons, prayers, "I am" descriptions

Gospel's target people: Mark for Paul's Churches; Matthew for Jewish Community; Luke for Gentile Community; John for Synagogue Exiles

**Question for Pondering:** What happens to our understanding of Jesus when we read the New Testament in the order in which the books were written (chronological), not the order of the standard Bible?
