Book Club, Monday, May 24, 11am on ZOOM continuing our journey through <u>The Road Less</u> <u>Traveled</u>.



Raley's shopping center. We are gathering in memory of Margaret Duecker, who loved lunch bunch so very much. But even if you never met her, you are very welcome to join us!



"A teacher," Harold replied.


Sign outside Mansfield, OH, church: "Too hot to keep changing sign. Sin bad, Jesus good. Details inside."
