At our June Lunch Bunch gathering, a suggestion was given to visit El Arcoiris Taqueria for our July gathering. This being a new restaurant for our Lunch Bunch group. Pastor Mary and I decided to visit the 520 N.

Lincoln Way establishment for lunch last week.

Now, I was apprehensive about visiting a place I hadn't been to before - especially inviting a group there also. We were pleasantly surprised on our arrival.

It's a very small place with perhaps 10 tables in the room. Our group would definitely take over at least half of the room. Orders and payment are made at the counter.

Pastor Mary already knew what she wanted - a veggie burrito (without the tortilla) served in a bowl (\$7.73 including drink). For me, there's too many choices! I finally settled on a #1- 3 taco plate, with fresh cooked beans and rice (\$11.33 including drink)



I had to make another choice! Do you want beef, pork, or chicken? Ok, I'll take pork carnitas. Oh dear, I have to make another choice? Street taco or Americano taco? Ok, I'll take the Americano taco with grilled tortilla. Faye Gaines was invited to join us. She chose #7 - 2 tacos (\$6.65 including drink) She had to make those other choices and ordered Americano tacos with with asada (that's beef!).

Our orders made, we settled down for a wait while our meals were custom prepared for us. It was a brief 7 minutes and our take-out order was ready. The take out food was served in standard take out containers. I noticed several eat-in tables were served in flat paper type plates with plastic eating utensils.

One of the bonus items was a self service salsa bar with 10 different types of salsa - everything from mild to blazing hot, and red color to green.

As I said above, we were pleasantly delighted with El Arcoiris Taqueria and it definitely passed our inspection. We thank Alan and Michele Weinel for suggesting and making the 20 reservations for our July 1 lunch. The owners are requesting we arrive at their opening time of 11:00.

Here are some side notes: 11:00 too early for lunch? I did notice a breakfast section on their menu board. One item caught my attention - Huevos ranchero. - - When you arrive go directly to the counter and place your order, don't wait until everyone arrives. - - Parking is very limited, carpool if possible.
