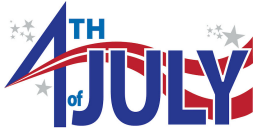

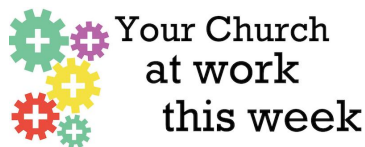

we blessed that Galt UMC is one of the things he loves! You are a treasure, Pastor Joe. Words cannot express our gratitude to you!



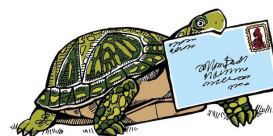
Pastor Mary is taking two weeks of vacation from June 14 – June 28. During this time Pastor Joe will cover any pastoral e m e r g e n c i e s
