When my husband was diagnosed with Stage 4 lung cancer at age 53, we were not prepared for all the decisions ahead. Our son John was only in Kindergarten and our daughter Zola just in preschool. It had never occurred to us as new parents, with a thriving ministry, that we needed to take time out to consider what planning was needed to have a death consistent with the values of our life. So,

looking back now at the five months we had with Boikanyo between his diagnosis and death, I know his suffering would have been eased had we thought through the principles of a "Good End": don't leave a mess, do leave a legacy, live the best life you can. We are blessed to have in our Church a woman who has walked the path of catastrophic diagnosis and who is skilled at teaching others how to ask and answer the deep questions of life and death. Colleen Hurley joined Galt UMC last November and is a retired educator from Galt. She works as an End-of-Life Doula, providing emotional, physical, and educational aid to dying persons and/or their family. She has been a Hospice volunteer for 6 years. Together, we will be holding a two-part Seminar on Sept. 19 and Sept 26 from 2-4pm in our Galt UMC Social Hall. Registration is limited. You will find a registration form in this newsletter.
