If you are new to the United Methodist Church our system may take a little getting used to. For that matter, even if you've been around a while, it can! Every fall we have a "Charge Conference" to elect leaders for the following calendar year. This year our Charge Conference is on October 18, so the hunt is on! The Nominations and Leadership Development Committee, which I convene, is <u>looking for people to serve on Trustees</u>, Finance, and Staff Parish Relations <u>Committee</u>. A three year term is typical, but shorter terms are possible if you want to "try out" a committee and see if it is a good fit. Please let me know <u>this week</u> if you are interested in any of the following:

<u>TRUSTEES</u>: cares for the buildings and property of Galt UMC; meets monthly, plus in between monthly meetings on occasion for repair and maintenance projects; if our Mission Proposal is adopted

by the Conference and our local Church, then the Trustees will take the lead on the plan for the Sunshine Food Pantry & Resource Center.

<u>FINANCE</u>: cares for the gifts received and spent by Galt UMC; meets monthly; also communicates with the congregation about the offerings needed for supporting staff and ministry expenses.

<u>STAFF-PARISH RELATIONS COMMITTEE</u>: evaluates the work of all staff, including the appointed Pastor, and makes recommendations to our District Superintendent about whether to keep the current Pastor or request a new one; also makes recommendations to Finance and Church Council about the salary package for the appointed Pastor.

What is the <u>CHURCH COUNCIL</u>, inquiring minds want to know? Chairs of each of the above Committees, plus the Membership Secretary, Finance

Secretary, Treasurer, Lay Member to Annual Conference, Lay Leader, and At-Large-Members, convene monthly to approve decisions made by the Committees and to share information and pray together.

I love working with members of these Committees on fulfilling the mission and ministry of Jesus Christ to make disciples for the transformation of the world. I hope those of you who are not yet serving as leaders will step up and enjoy the challenges and gifts of the experience.

Meets this Saturday, September 18, 9:00am at Velvet Grill. All are invited to enjoy the fellowship.




