

Dear Galt United Methodist Church Members,

Grace and Peace to you in the Living Spirit of our Lord Jesus Christ! We have been authorized by our Central Valley District Superintendent to have a SPECIAL CHURCH CONFERENCE on Thursday, October 14 at 6:30pm in person in our Sanctuary. The purpose will be to take a vote on the selling of our Church's two empty lots to Christian Church Homes for the development of affordable housing for seniors and veterans, with proceeds from the sale to be held in trust for building a free-standing Sunshine Food Pantry & Resource Center on the lot adjacent to our parking lot. Every official member has a vote at this Church Conference.

For the past year, the Exploratory Committee has been looking into all the possibilities for how to transform these lots into a blessing for our Church and for our beloved Galt community. You have received frequent updates from the newsletter, town hall meetings, and from the pulpit. Bishop Minerva Carcaño and District Superintendent David Niu met with me last week in the wake of receiving our written mission proposal and are supportive of this sale.

Some things to bear in mind:

- 1) Christian Church Homes (CCH) is seeking funding through our City and County to make their project affordable. Even if we vote yes on selling, there is still a possibility that CCH may not buy. If they walk away from the purchase, then the vote at this Special Church Conference is no longer in effect.
- 2) If the sale happens, then a special Building Committee will be established that will include members of our Board of Trustees with the charge to develop the Sunshine Food Pantry & Resource Center and to bring it to completion by taking it through the UMC and City approval process.
- 3) The cost of building and furnishing the Sunshine Food Pantry & Resource Center will be approximately a million dollars. Fundraising toward that amount will focus on government grants, gifts from non-profit groups, local businesses, and individual donors. Our Galt UMC contribution toward this million dollars will be the \$200,000 we anticipate receiving from CCH for the sale of the lots. A Fundraising Committee will be established with people from the community, as well as members of our Church.
