




Wednesdays - 6:30pm, on Facebook Live

He also famously taught in Chapter 14 that "I will pray with the spirit, but I will pray with the mind also; I will sing praise with the spirit, but I will sing praise with the mind also." Tonga UPDATE Our circuit raised the \$7000

necessary to send the large shipping container to Tonga filled with things the Tongans from the United Methodist Church in Stockton knew from their family members were needed for rebuilding after the volcano and tsunami. Pastor Tevita thanks all of you who contributed from Galt UMC!

Ukraine: We have received a total of \$2976 for The United Methodist Committee on Relief (UMCOR) Ukraine fund thus far. UMCOR gives 100% of donations to the causes they are designated for. For the rest of Lent through Easter, there will be an offering plate on the altar for you to put donations for Ukraine - these donations are being used to help relieve the current humanitarian refugee crisis, as well as potential rebuilding once the war is over. You can give cash or make a check out to Galt UMC with "Ukraine UMCOR" in the memo or you can make your check out directly to UMCOR with Ukraine in the memo and we will get the checks where it needs to go.
