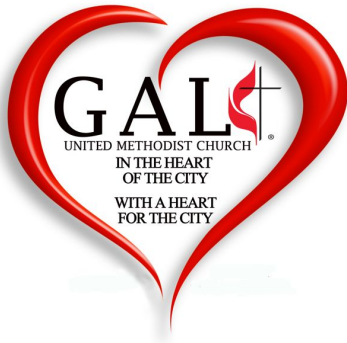


Galt UMC This Week

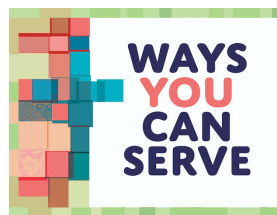

UMC on Tuesday, August 9.

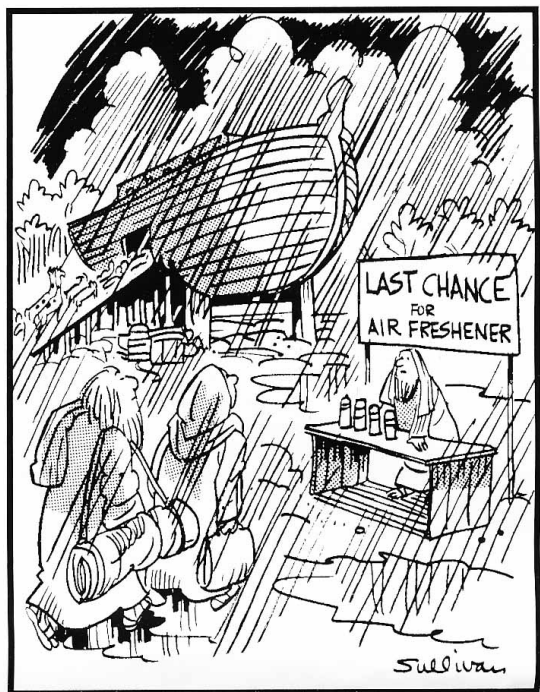
While she is away Pastor Norm

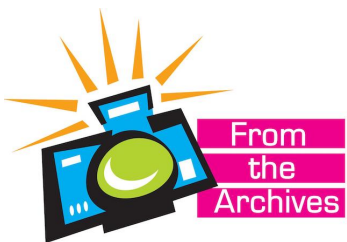
Sunshine Food Pantry volunteer Betti Welch, presented an appreciation plaque to Mike King, president of Galt Sunrise Rotary
