Our Finance Committee is hard at work even between the monthly meetings, which are open to any member of the Church who would like to attend. Reports are yours for the asking whether you serve on the Finance Committee or not. However, as Church Finance Secretary Earl Arrants likes to say, the reports take a little explaining to be

understood. We use a software program that helps us to break down categories for our reports to the United Methodist Conference, but there is a bit of a learning curve before the numbers make sense. But here is what I can assure everyone who gives to our beloved Galt UMC - every penny you give is accounted for with care and gratitude. Serving on Finance is actually very spiritual as we move forward with plans, to be sure, but also sometimes on a "wing and a prayer" as our current Chair Ann Mitchell, likes to say. We would love to have you join this team in 2023. Current members are: Ann Mitchell, Chair: Eva Roach, Treasurer: Earl Arrants. Finance Secretary; Offering Counters/Members at Large, Fave Gaines & Pearl Silva. Your giving is confidential and known only to the counters. As your Pastor I choose not to know who gives what financially. I assume everyone is giving what they can.

The most important work the Finance Committee does for our Church family is recommend a yearly They make this recommendation based on input from Earl Arrants (as Finance Secretary he has his finger on the pulse of giving), and recommendations from Staff Parish Relations Committee, since the lion's share of our budget is for staff. In the next two weeks the Finance Committee will be drafting a 2023 Budget that will then be made available in this newsletter and as a handout at Worship. We will have a Special Church Council meeting to discuss and vote on the 2023 Budget after Worship on Sunday, September 25. All members and friends of the Church are encouraged to attend. Everyone has a voice, though only Church Council members can vote. More next week.
